RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS (RCIA)

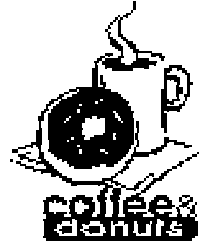

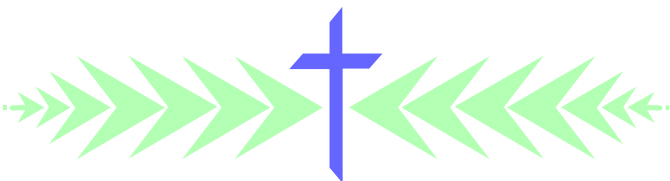
